

## **Jump Rope for Heart**

### **[School Participation Support Payment] – Conditions of Support**

#### **1. About this support payment**

The National Heart Foundation of Australia (**Heart Foundation**) offers a one-off participation support payment to support program delivery costs of the Jump Rope for Heart program for a limited number of eligible schools. Unless otherwise stated, the support payment is inclusive of GST. Where GST applies, a valid tax invoice must be provided.

This support payment:

- is not a competition, prize, draw or reward; and
- is not linked to fundraising performance or outcomes.

This payment is intended to support participation and is not guaranteed to all registering schools.

#### **2. Purpose**

The purpose of the support payment is to:

1. reduce barriers to entry for new and returning schools; and
2. recognise the time, planning and coordination required to implement Jump Rope for Heart.

#### **3. Amount and availability**

The support payment is \$500 per eligible school.

The offer is limited to a maximum of 50 schools.

Schools will be notified if they are eligible for the support payment.

Only one support payment per school is available.

#### **4. Eligible schools**

A school may receive the support payment if it:

1. is an Australian primary school (Prep to Year 6); and
2. registers by 31 May 2026 to participate in Jump Rope for Heart for the relevant school term; and

is either:

- a. a school that has not previously participated in Jump Rope for Heart (**New School**); or
- b. a school that has not registered in the program in the past three (3) years (**Lapsed School**).

#### **5. How schools are identified**

Eligible schools will be identified based on registration records and child participant registration in the Jump Rope for Heart system. Where more than 50 eligible schools register, the support payment will be offered to the first 50 eligible schools to complete registration (including child participant registration), based on system time stamps.

Once the allocation limit is reached, no further support payments will be made.

Schools that are not eligible due to the allocation limit being reached will be informed. Any disputes in relation to being an eligible school, registration order, system errors (including duplicate or inaccurate time stamps) or registration quotas will be at the Heart Foundation's sole discretion.

#### **6. Registration and acknowledgement**

By registering for Jump Rope for Heart, the registering teacher or school representative:

1. confirms they are authorised to register the school;
2. acknowledges these participation support conditions; and
3. any other conditions notified by the Heart Foundation regarding the Jump Rope for Heart program.

## **7. Participation requirement**

To ensure the support payment is applied to active participation:

payment may be made after the school has commenced the program, by achieving at least one of the following participation milestones:

1. registering its first student participant; or
2. holding its Jump Off Day.

The Heart Foundation will confirm the relevant participation milestone with each eligible school.

## **8. Payment method**

The support payment will be made to the school, or to a school nominated account (such as a P&C association), as approved by the Heart Foundation. The payment will not be made to an individual staff member. The school must provide an invoice for payment into the appropriate account. Once an invoice is accepted by the Heart Foundation, payment will be made within 30 days.

## **9. Use of funds**

The support payment is intended to be used for costs reasonably related to delivering Jump Rope for Heart, including setup, equipment or program activities. The Heart Foundation is not liable for any other costs incurred by the school and the Heart Foundation limits its liability strictly to the support payment amount.

The Heart Foundation does not require receipts but may request written details and confirmation that the program has been delivered.

## **10. Withdrawal or ineligibility**

If a school:

- A. withdraws from Jump Rope for Heart before commencing participation; or
  - B. is found not to meet the eligibility criteria (as set out in clauses 4, 5, 6, 7 8 and 9),
- the Heart Foundation may decide not to make the support payment, or may decide to recover the payment if it has already been provided.

## **11. Administrative changes**

The Heart Foundation may:

1. clarify administrative details relating to this support payment; or
2. close the offer once the maximum number of supported schools has been reached.

This will not affect schools that have already been confirmed as eligible.

The Heart Foundation may cancel or close this offer at any time in its sole discretion.

## **12. Privacy**

Personal information will be handled in accordance with the Heart Foundation's Privacy Policy, available at [www.heartfoundation.org.au/privacy-policy](http://www.heartfoundation.org.au/privacy-policy), and used only to administer Jump Rope for Heart and this support payment.

### **13. Governing law**

These conditions are governed by the laws of Victoria, Australia.
